FOR THE EPISTLE 1 Peter 2: 4-9

Brethren: Ye also. coming to the Lord, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.
